

Lake Timings

18:00 - 21:00

Clear the water by 21:00 or dusk whichever occurs soonest

Lake Rules

BEFORE AND AFTER THE SESSION

- Members should come ready to paddle. This is particularly important when other groups are using the changing rooms.
- Members must not enter or use the changing rooms at the same time as other groups. The disabled toilet can be used if required.
- A Bromley Canoe Club Duty Paddler must be present before any craft are launched.
- All paddlers must sign the Attendance Log before launching and sign off when they have left the water (parents/guardians must sign for youth members).
- At the end of the session all boats and equipment must be safely stored away. ALL members should help with this
- The decision of the Duty Paddler is final

DURING THE SESSION

- Members must take every care when paddling to ensure the safety of others
- There is to be NO swimming and NO jumping from the pontoons.
- Buoyancy Aids or Life Jackets and footwear must be worn at all times
- Helmets must be worn if playing in the overspill entry at the left hand side of the lake.
- Individuals should not paddle in groups of less than three (3)
- Youth members must always be accompanied by an adult

MEMBERS MUST NOT GO WITHIN 20 METERS OF ANYONE FISHING UNLESS IN AN EMERGENCY
