Members

- Treat other Club members with respect at all times - both on and off the water - treat others as you would like to be treated yourself.
- Take care of all property belonging to the Club and other members.
- Report all missing or damaged equipment to the Club equipment officer or other member of the committee.
- Members are required to behave in a manner becoming to the club and to behave honourably.
- Co-operate with and listen to Club officials and coaches.
- Consider the well-being and safety of all paddlers.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, experience and ability of those taking part.
- Wear appropriate kit for canoeing.
- Be responsible for looking after your own equipment (be it borrowed from club or personal).
- Consider the well-being and safety of all paddlers.
- If you have a medical condition that coaches should be made aware of please inform them and make them aware of any changes in your condition and treatment.

Parents/Guardians

- Treat other Club members with respect at all times - both on and off the water - treat others as you would like to be treated yourself.
- Take care of all property belonging to the Club and other members.
- Report all missing or damaged equipment to the Club equipment officer or other member of the committee.

- Members are required to behave in a manner becoming to the club and to behave honourably.
- Co-operate with and listen to Club officials and coaches.
- Consider the well-being and safety of all paddlers.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, experience and ability of those taking part.
- Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy canoeing.
- Never force your child to take part in canoeing.
- Provide written medical details appertaining to your child, update the club welfare officer or another member of the committee if there is a change in your child's medical condition.
- Provide completed and signed consent forms as required.

Junior Members (Under 18)

- Co-operate fully, respecting all requests and decisions made by Coaches, supervisors, lifeguards and helpers.
- Be considerate and respectful of other Club members at all times - both on and off the water - treat others as you would like to be treated yourself.
- Take care of all property belonging to the Club and other members.
- Report all missing or damaged equipment to the Club equipment officer or other member of the committee.
- Wear appropriate kit for canoeing.
- Be responsible for looking after your own equipment (be it borrowed from club or personal).
- Members are required to behave in a manner becoming to the club and to behave honourably.
- Do not leave a session (other than Monday night pool sessions) without the permission of the Coach, lifeguard or helper.
- Consider the well-being and safety of all paddlers.
- Do not smoke or consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst on Club trips or events.
- Parent or guardian must be aware of any medication required whilst on a trip or activity (guardian includes any adult acting as the appointed guardian for the duration of a trip / event).
