West Wickham Leisure Centre Swimming Pool Rules



These rules are to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all members.

Pool Timings:

20:00 – 20:30	Priority is given to 15yrs & under
20:30 – 20:30	(Parents who have children attending
20.30 21.00	these sessions can also paddle)
21:00 – 21:30	16yrs & over only
21:30 – 22:00	

The Rules:

- 1. The West Wickham Pool lifeguard and the Club Supervisor (yellow shirt) must be present before activities commence.
- 2. No equipment should be removed from the club store until the pool has been vacated by the general public.
- 3. Children are to be kept out of the store area.
- 4. Boats and kit must be clean before pool use.
- 5. Boats and other equipment brought to the Pool must only enter the Pool via the changing rooms and be washed down before it is brought to poolside.
- 6. No sharp edged or damaged equipment to be brought into the pool.
- 7. Sixteen boats is the maximum permitted in the pool at any one time.
- 8. No seal launching from the poolside.
- 9. Please swim and relax in the swimming lane and observe the centre's rules as displayed.
- 10. When teaching, be aware of the pupil and other dangers.
- 11. When paddling, be aware of coaches and other paddlers.
- 12. Please ensure that everyone has the opportunity to paddle. Personal boats should also be offered to others wishing to paddle.
- 13. When practising freestyle techniques (pirouettes, cartwheeling, looping etc.), check that you have the required space and that it is safe to do so.
- 14. The open canoe should be limited to three occupants, with no standing close to the poolside.
- 15. Please ensure that boats are kept clear of the swimming lane at all times.
- 16. Ensure that equipment is removed from the pool and returned to storage as soon as the pool session has ended.
- 17. Please respect the times and makeup of each of the four half hour sessions and promptly vacate all boats at the end of each session.
- 18. All under 16s must leave the pool at 21:00 there can be no exceptions.
- 19. No hanging on the lane markers or ropes.
- 20. No swimming in the canoeing area.
- 21. Spectators should use the viewing gallery.
- 22. Photography of pool activities is not permitted without specific authority.
- 23. Anyone coming on to poolside wearing shoes must wear the blue plastic overshoes provide at the entrance.
- 24. The West Wickham Pool lifeguard's and the Club supervisor's decisions are final.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in you being required to leave the pool.
