21:00 – 21:30 21:30 – 22:00	16yrs & over only

Pool Rules

THE SESSION

- The session must not start without a Centre lifeguard and a BCC pool supervisor present
- No more than 20 boats should be on the water at any one time
- Under 16s must not enter the storage area
- At the end of the session all boats and equipment must be safely stored
- Please respect the times of the sessions and vacate all boats at the end of each session
- Follow the Centre rules on photography and video

WHILST PADDLING

- No seal launching is allowed unless using a protective mat
- Members must take every care when paddling to ensure the safety of others
- Swimming will only be allowed when there are no boats on the water
- When practicing freestyle techniques (pirouettes, cartwheeling, looping etc.), check that you have the required space and that it is safe to do so.

PERSONAL BOATS AND OTHER STUFF

- Personal boats and equipment must be in good condition and clean before use in the pool
- Personal boats must always be brought in via the fire escape which goes directly outside
- All under 16s must leave the pool at the end of their session
- Spectators must remain in the viewing area
- No outdoor footwear is allowed on poolside
- Personal boats should be offered to others to paddle in the event of a split session

THE POOL LIFEGUARD'S AND THE CLUB SUPERVISOR'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL
Failure to abide by these rules may result in you being required to leave the pool.
